Fact Sheets and Letters to Residents

Council wrote to residents in the vicinity of the airport and airport stakeholders in July. This information has also been put into <u>fact sheets</u> and uploaded to the <u>project page</u> for the community and stakeholders.

Project Updates:

Site Establishment Phase

- 1. Site establishment complete
- 2. The Asphalt plant is in the process of being installed and will start running within the next week to be calibrated before it will start properly from the 17 August 2020
- 3. The Airport Ground Lighting (AGL) trenching for the pit and duct work has started
- 4. Apron Fillet Extension works has started
- 5. The Runway Pavement Works are now due to start approximately 17/18 August.

The project team have asked us to note in this update that the majority of the works disruption will be completed by the end of November – at this stage. However, this is subject to weather and other delays that may occur. We will keep the community and stakeholders updated as works progress.
