

Naming of Waterbody – Eli Waters

This fact sheet provides details relating to public consultation for the naming of a waterbody in Eli Waters.

BACKGROUND:

Council resolved to undertake consultation with the local community to determine an appropriate name for a waterbody located in the suburb of Eli Waters.

Local residents and park users who adjoin this waterbody are being invited to submit name suggestions for further consideration by the Council.

One local community group has suggested the waterbody be named “**Lake Eli**”.

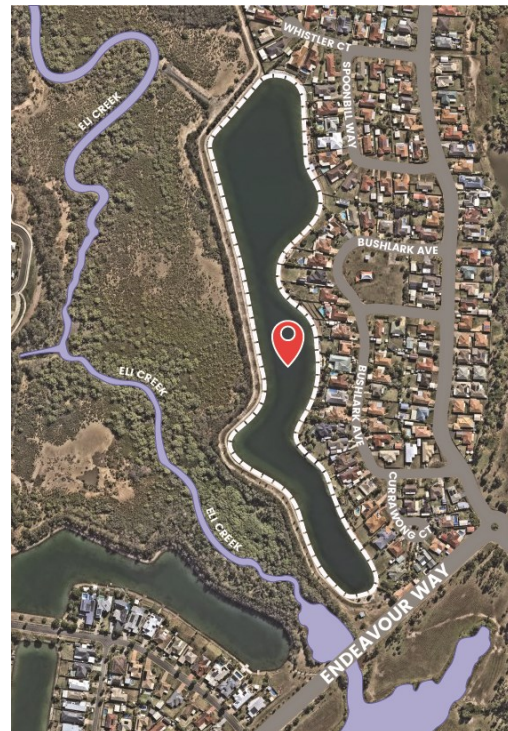
